Worship Notes – The author of our second hymn is Rev. William Walsham How. Rev. How was born in Shrewsbury, England in 1823. He studied at Oxford and Durham University and was ordained into the Church of England in 1847. As a bishop, he was known as "the poor man's bishop" and as the "children's bishop" for his work among the destitute in the London slums and among the factory workers in west Yorkshire. He wrote a number of theological works and over sixty hymns including many for children. Rev. How died in Ireland in 1897 at the age of 74.
